Susan B. Anthony

- 26 Founded International Woman Suffrage Council.
- 26 Died in Rochester, New York.
- 29 Winner of first presidential election after passage of 19th Amendment, which was based on an amendment she wrote in 1878.
- 39 Dollar coin bearing her likeness was first minted.

William Jennings Bryan

- 25 Gave his “Cross of Gold” speech shortly before his losing campaign against this president.
- 27 Lost his third presidential campaign to him.
- 28 Was his first Secretary of State.
- 30 Strongly opposed Al Smith as Democratic nominee because Smith opposed prohibition.
- 30 Participated in the Scopes Trial in Tennessee.

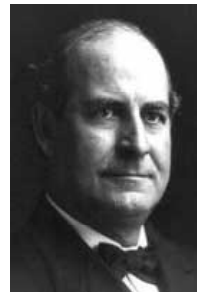
Clarence Darrow

- 26 Defended McNamara Brothers charged with dynamiting *Los Angeles Times* building.
- 28 Co-founded the American Civil Liberties Union.
- 30 Represented Leopold and Loeb; convinced them to plead guilty to avoid death penalty.
- 30 Defended John Scopes in the “Monkey Trial.”

Eugene Debs

- 25 First ran for president for Social Democratic Party.
- 28 Arrested under the Espionage Act.
- 29 Winner of the election in which he ran from prison.
- 29 Released when his sentence was commuted by this president.

W.E.B. Dubois

- 25 Presidential winner in year he became first African-American to obtain a Ph.D. from Harvard.
- 27 Helped found the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People.
- 27 Left his teaching position at Atlanta University to become Editor-in-Chief of the NAACP publication *The Crisis*.
- 28 Published his pioneering book *The Negro*.
- 32 Left *The Crisis* and returned to Atlanta University.
- 35 Died as a citizen of Ghana and a member of the Communist Party at age 95.

Huey Long

- 28 Passed Louisiana Bar Exam without completing a law degree.
- 28 Elected Chairman of the Louisiana Railroad Commission on an anti-Standard Oil platform.
- 30 Lost his first race for Governor.
- 30 Won the governorship with a slogan of “every man a king, but no one wears a crown.”
- 31 Withstood impeachment in the state legislature.
- 31 Elected to the U.S. Senate while still governor.
- 32 Assassinated in Capitol Building in Baton Rouge.

Gloria Steinem

- 35 Wrote an undercover article “A Bunny’s Tale.”
- 37 Co-founded National Women’s Political Caucus.
- 37 Founded feminist magazine *Ms*.
- 37 Founded Colation of Labor Union Women.
- 42 Inducted into the National Women’s Hall of Fame.
