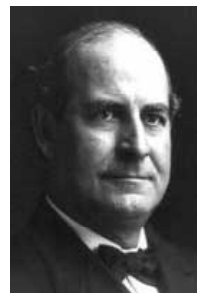
_____ First ran for president for Social Democratic Party.
