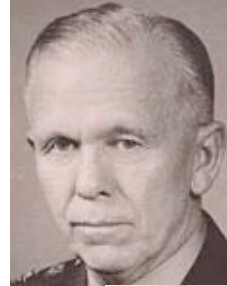

- 32 Chooses Eisenhower as Europe Commander. '43
- 32 First general promoted to 5 star rank. 1944
- 33 Named Secretary of State. 1947
- 33 Announces European Recovery Program. 1947
- 33 Resigns from State Department. 1949
- 33 Appointed Secretary of Defense. 1950
- 34 Awarded Nobel Peace Prize for Marshall Plan '53

Douglas MacArthur (1880-1964)
